Those students wishing to become Peace Officers in the State of California are required to attend and complete the RBC. The POST Entry-Level Law Enforcement Test Battery must be completed with a passing score of at least 44.5 to enter the Fresno City College POST Basic Police Academy.

Law enforcement entrance exam components The main components of any law enforcement selection process include a written exam with several components, physical agility test, an oral interview, a psychological evaluation, medical exam, and a background investigation.

The Sacramento Police Academy is a P.O.S.T. intensive format and is 24 weeks in length. It is generally a 4-10 work week (four days per week, ten hours per day), for a total of 942 hours of training. The schedule may change slightly during some weeks to accommodate training needs (range, emergency driving course, etc.).

The courses are certified by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.). In order for someone to be eligible to serve as a full time Peace Officer in California, completion of the Basic Police Academy is required. Completion of this Academy will result in 28.5 units of college credit being awarded.

The POST decides which exam will be used as the entry-level police exam. The NPOST is just one of those exams. Other exams they may choose are the LEAB by EB Jacobs, the Nelson Denny Reading Test or tests provided by I/O Solutions. For example, the California POST developed and administers the PELLETB.
