Ex-offenders are not a protected class. A 2004 public act, dealing with the Department of Corrections (DOC), and a 2005 act, addressing state supportive housing needs, provides insight into what (1) the state is doing to assist ex-offenders and (2) else the state could do to help them find adequate housing. In other words, DOC provides house planning in its discharge plans for ex-offenders and the state is creating supportive units for certain ex-offenders, but adequate housing is not always ...

Men and women released from correctional facilities receive minimal preparation and inadequate assistance and resources, which makes their re-entry into communities challenging (Visher & Mallik-Kane, 2007). A criminal conviction limits employment prospects, public housing assistance and social services (Coates, 2015).
